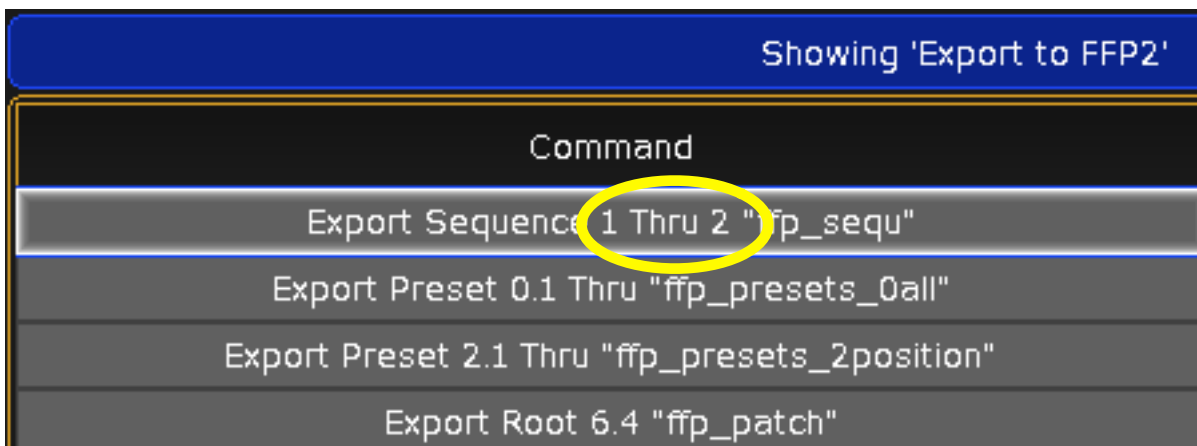


FFP2 IMPORT and PHOTOS

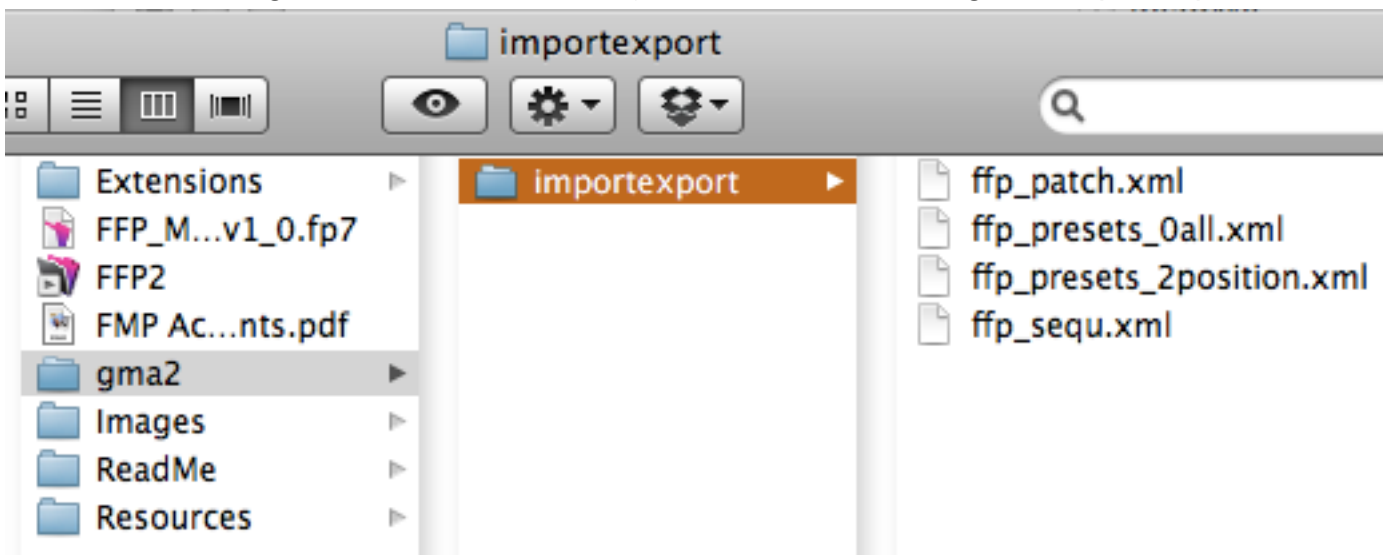
Import the macro "Export to FFP2" to the console



Edit the first line of the macro to export only the Sequences you are interested in. The more sequences you export, the longer the import process will take.



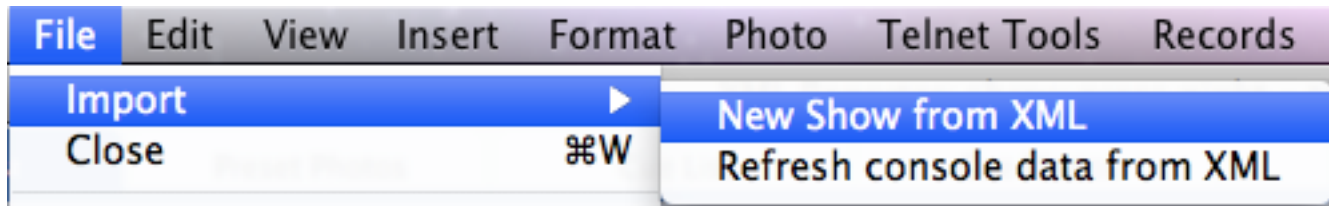
In the Backup Menu, select the drive you wish to send the XML files to, then run the macro. Now, drag the xml files created by the macro to /FFP2/gma2/importexport.



The standard filepath has been used in case you are using an FTP server, in which case, you can have the console send the files to this location directly.

Now open FFP2, and use the Guest radio button to log in.

Make sure you are connected to the Internet, then click File>Import>New Show from XML



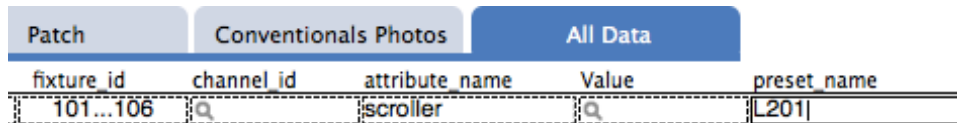
Choosing 'Refresh console data from XML' will re-import console data, but will keep any notes you have made.

Basic Reporting.

Please read the filemaker guides from filemaker.com for more advanced techniques, but here's a quick overview:

Q: Do fixtures 101 thru 106 use scroller colour L201?

1. Go to 'All Data' Tab
2. Press Ctrl+F (Command+F on OS X)
3. In the fixture_id field, type '101...106' (3 x period '...' = thru)
4. In the attribute_name field, type "scroller"
5. In the preset_name field, type 'L201'



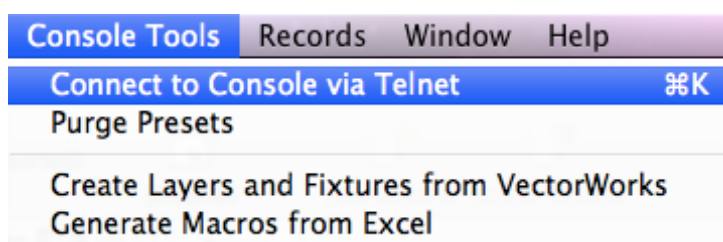
6. Press return.

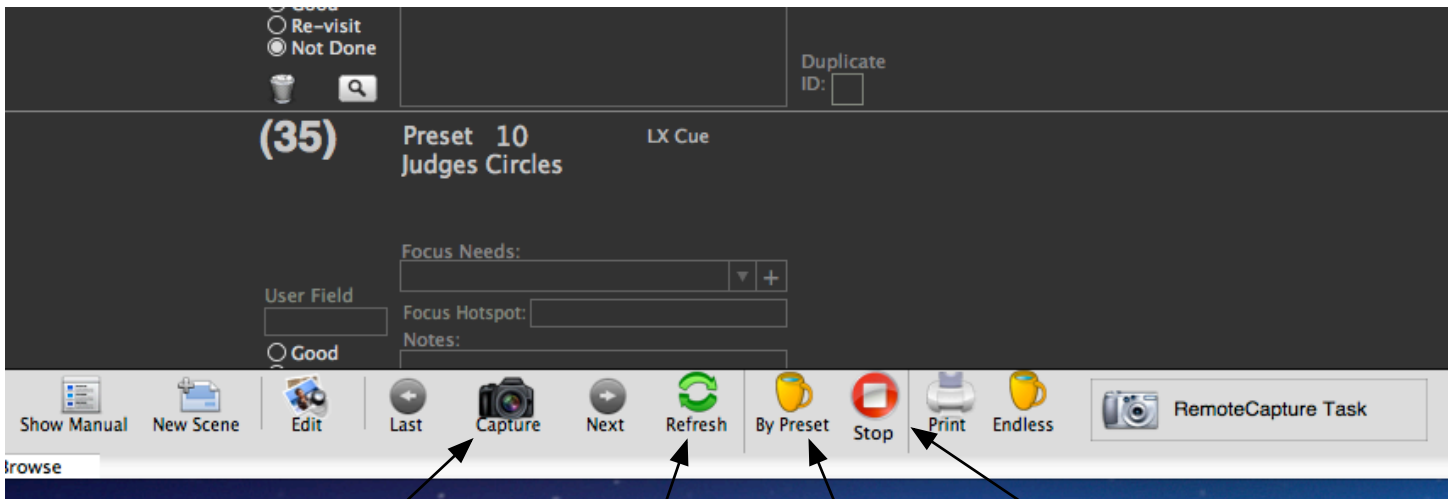
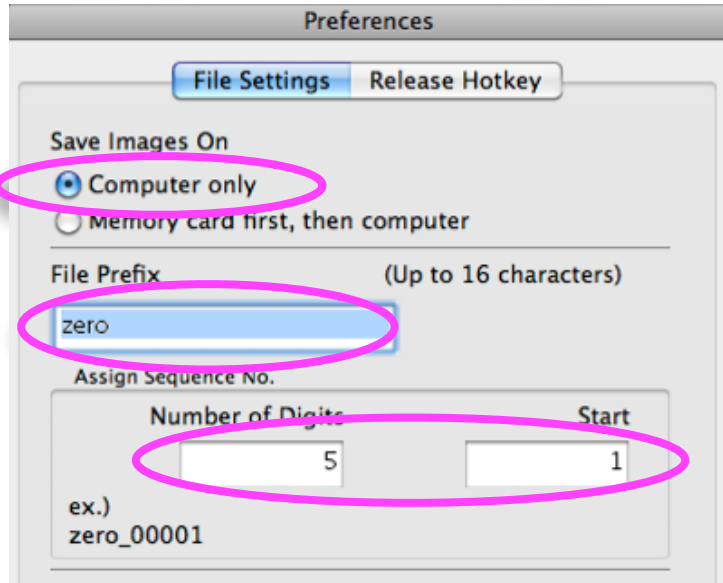
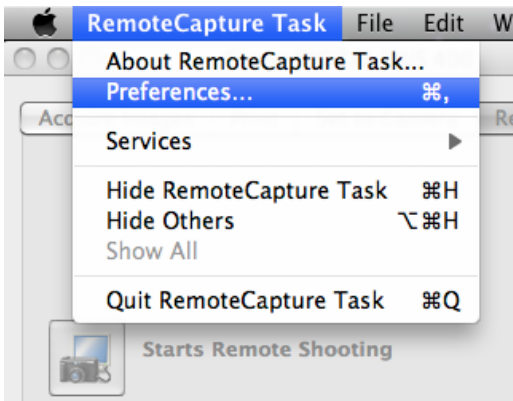
A list of all places where fixtures 101 thru 106 is displayed

Mac OS X Users can control the console and a camera to automatically take pictures of Presets, Cues and Conventional Channels.

Choose 'Connect To Console', then enter the IP address of the console.



In RemoteCapture preferences, settings as follows:



Takes picture and imports

Sends command to console

Will take pictures of everything in the list

Press to stop
